

I am looking for information about the William Hill Family.

William was born at Ashreigney, 22 Jan. 1797 and died at Charles/Brayford , 1857 and possibly was buried at Rose Ash Feb 1857. His daughter in law, Eliza, Rock Hill , was the informant living at Ditchett Farm, Rose Ash, at the time of William's death. William's son John and family were there at Rose Ash in 1857. Evidently he (William) was ill for 12 months prior to his death, according to his death certificate. I have searched Brayford and Charles cemeteries with no luck. Rose Ash has no parish clerk that I can see and therefore no info.

I would like to know where William Hill d. 1857 is buried (Rose Ash??), along with his wife, Mary Chapple Hill, born 27 April, 1797, Bishops Nympton and died 1883, likely at Charles, Devon. Mary Chapple Hill lived with son William Hill at the time of death at Brayford. My hunch is that both may be at Rose Ash, St. Peters cemetery. Are William and Mary Chapple Hill buried at Rose Ash? Are John and Eliza (Rock) Hill buried at Rose Ash? Any other information about this family would be greatly appreciated. I also know that William and Mary Chapple Hill's children Sarah, b. 1817(my grandmother) was born/christened at Rose Ash, others all born at Knowstone were Thomas, b. 1819, William 1821, John 1822, Mary 1825 (married Philip Rock) Elizabeth b. 1827 (married Chamings), Anthony b. 1829.
