Jockey rules

All jockeys are amateurs and have declared no previous experience of hobby horse racing. It is all about technique so the most stylish jockey is unlikely to be the winner.

- Ian Brooks is the official adjudicator for the evening and has the last word on riding style and foul play. Cheating will result in disqualification.
- All horses will be inspected pre the race to check for signs of sabotage and the employment of dirty tricks.
 Horses must not be interfered with during the race.
- All jockeys must keep their elbows on their knees and WIND the rope. Horses cannot be pulled over the line.
- All jockeys must remain seated in the chair. This means no Frankie Dettori impressions until your horse has won.
- The winning horse will win by a nose i.e. it will be the horse whose nose touches the chair first.
- Anthony Vigus is your official commentator for the evening and will be calling the horses home.
- Jockeys will not be asked to weigh in before or after races nor need to complete a breath test. In fact the committee actively encourage participants to visit the bar pre saddling up.
- No whips. All other riding paraphernalia is acceptable.
- There are a number of spare rides due to jockeys having other commitments, bans or being deemed unfit to ride.
 Any wannabee jockeys should express their interest with Rosie and Andrew at the door. Names will be selected from a hat.
