Most often referred to as a Parish Plan, sometimes a Community Plan, this is a good process for drawing communities together, identifying needs, opinions and the scope for community development.

If you would like help to:

- Consider undertaking a CLP for the first time
- Updating your existing plan (They usually have a life span of about five years.)
- Help with moving your planning process forward
- Advice on implementing your plan
