

## COMPETITION TERMS

- Unless specified all classes are open to all to enter.
- No entries from 2017, 2018 and 2019 are to be submitted.
- All exhibits must be of the exhibitors' own growing or making, except in Classes 13, 16 and 17 where shop bought items may be used.
- Exhibitors may enter only one exhibit in any one class.
- Further entry forms are available on the Knowstone Parish website. The main point of contact is Wendy Vigus (01398 341159).
- Entry fees are 50p per class. All fees need to be paid with the entry form.
- Payment can be made in cash or by cheque (made payable to Knowstone Village Hall)
- **Entries for the photography section must be no bigger than A4 size. Any entries over A4 size will be disqualified from the competition.**
- **Entries for class 4 should be no bigger than A2 size.**
- Classes 9 and 12 must follow the recipe supplied. Class 12 is restricted to men only. Classes 5, 6, 11, 17 and 22 are restricted to children only.
- The children only classes are open to those aged 16 and under. Please state age on entry form.
- For fairness purposes the organisers may split the Children classes by age.
- Exhibits must be brought to the Parish Hall **9am - 11am on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2020**. Entries brought in after 11am will not be permitted to enter.
- Your exhibit will be given a number for judging purposes and otherwise will be anonymous to ensure the judging process is fair.
- Judging is to take place between noon and 1pm and the main hall will be closed during this time. Viewing of exhibits can commence from 1pm.
- There will be a first, second, third and highly commended awarded in each class if entries are sufficient and if the judge merits it appropriate.
- It is recommended that all food items are covered with a transparent cover.
- Please note on the entry form if you are unwilling to sell your bakery items. All bakery items which are not to be sold to the general public must be removed from the hall at 3.30pm. At 4pm all remaining bakery items will be put on sale. Please ensure that sale items are on paper plates and you have retrieved your boxes / crockery prior to sale.
- The Parish Hall committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit that may occur at the show.
