3. A posy of flowers made from wool or textiles
4. “Junkyard Challenge” (maximum size 50cm square)

Baking/Cookery

5. Lemon Drizzle Cake
6. A decorated Focaccia
7. 4 savoury scones
8. A jar of chutney
9. Plate of sandwiches for a vintage village cricket match(include details of filling with entry)
10. A bottle of homemade alcoholic drink

Flowers / Produce

COMPETITION TERMS

- Unless specified, classes are open to all to enter.
- Classes 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29 are restricted to children only (those aged 14 and under). Please state age on entry form.
- Class 30 is open to Knowstone parish residents only for ease of judging.
- Exhibitors may enter only one exhibit in any one class.
- No entries from previous Knowstone shows are to be submitted.
- Entry fees are 50p per class.
- Payment can be made in cash, via BACS or by cheque (made payable to Knowstone Village Hall).
- Entries for the photography section must be no bigger than A4 size. Any entries over A4 size will be disqualified from the competition.
- All exhibits must be of the exhibitors' own growing or making, except in Classes 14, 15 and 26 where shop bought flora / produce may be used.
- All food items should be covered with a transparent cover. Classes 8 and 10 should be exhibited in a clear jar with the make and date of making shown on a small label. Class 9 should be accompanied by filling information.
- In classes 5–10 and 27 & 28 please provide details of any ingredients for allergy purposes.
- Class 28 – pizza bases may be shop bought
- Class 2 – please include a photo of the original hat before decoration.
- Exhibits must be brought to the Parish Hall between 9am– 11am on Saturday 15th August 2026. Entries brought in after 11am cannot be entered.
- Your exhibit will be given a number for judging purposes and otherwise will be anonymous to ensure the judging process is fair.
- Exhibitors are responsible for arranging their own exhibits on the day.
- Judging is to take place between 11am and 1pm and the main hall will be closed during this time. Public viewing can commence from 1pm.
- There will be a first, second and third awarded in each class if entries are sufficient and if the judge merits it appropriate.
- The Parish Hall committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit that may occur at the show.
- Scarecrows must be displayed from Monday 10th August in order that they can be judged during the week. They must be able to be seen from the road.
