Our objectives are fourfold :-

- 1) To maintain the hall and improve facilities where possible
- 2) To run events for the parish

- Re 1) Ken Dykes has put together some successful applications to the Batsworthy fund for improvements to our hall. There will be **competitions** for all ages in **art**, **photography**, **flowers**, **cakes** and **vegetables**. And there'll be a **dog show** so polish up your pooch. We are currently working on ideas for future events ideas welcome!
- Re 3) We make thoughtful use of the media to ensure that people in Devon are aware of what we have to offer and people come from far and wide especially for the regular **Dance Nights.**

Re 4) The parish website not only has details of all our events, but also some very useful information on our parish hall – floor plan, inventory, dimensions, facilities (eg projection equipment) and this has generated many bookings – Aston Martin Owners Club Ferrari Owners Club, Devon Doctors – they recognise a really good facility when they read about it; and we also advertise in 'In Touch' and our local newspapers & news sheets.

My thanks to all members of the Hall Committee for their hard work and imaginative ideas for activities and events.
